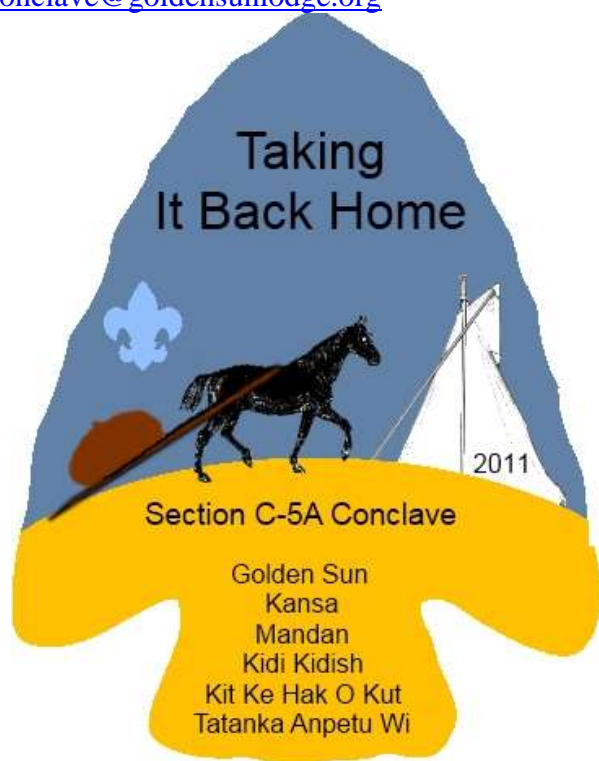
September 9 – 11, 2011 at Camp Cornhusker is going to be a fantastic time!

Camping Assignments

With the Coronado Area Council Emergency Plan in mind we will be assigning campsites for the Fall Fellowship and section Conclave. If a storm or emergency occurs we have people assigned to clear campsites and areas. **No vehicles are to leave the parking area except those that have been assigned by the Camp Ranger.**

All tents will be in a campsite area. If you can't see the pavilion or Latrine for your assigned campsite you will be asked to move your tent into the campsite area. This is for your safety and will help us to be able to clear your campsite in case of storm or emergency.

No vehicles will be allowed into the campsites. If the weather permits we will allow a vehicle to take your gear to the edge of the campsite to unload. Then the vehicle will return *immediately* to the parking area.
