

CIT Camp Hansen 2012

The CIT program was designed to give a Scout the opportunity to experience being on Camp staff in different areas. While a CIT doesn't spend the whole summer at camp, he may serve a week or 2 at camp in different areas to see what would best suit him when he is 16 or has the time to spend all of the summer at camp.

This year we have several that have applied, as CIT's and I will be sending out a letter of agreement to these Scouts and list when it will be that we can use their assistance to help in the program areas. We had 3 CIT applications last year and this year so far we have 17. I will do my best to give each applicant a chance to spend some time at Camp to assist in the program. Some of the factors that limit us to how many weeks we will or can use a CIT are:

1. Program area needs
2. Age of the CIT (There are some areas I can't work a 14 or 15 year old)
3. Number of bed space available

We will have a pre camp CIT meeting at the Scout office in Salina in April. At this meeting we will cover the Staff manual and any expectations we have of you as a Staff member and cover any questions you may have. If you can't attend I will try to set up a conference call number.

You will need 2 complete scout uniforms for the week(s) you are there. We have laundry facilities you will be able to use. We will supply you a (1) staff shirt. If I have funding available we will give you a clothing allowance to help cover a little of your expense. This will be reflected in your letter of agreement.
