Training is for Scout Leaders who:

- Would have an interest in assisting troops, packs, dens and boys at camp two or more weekends a year.
- Has ability in Scouting skills -- not necessarily an expert in all.
- Has the ability to get along with people (very important).
- Has acceptable character traits (follows the Scout Oath and Law).
- Is a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America, or would upon acceptance as Campmaster.
- Must attend a training session on how to be a successful Campmaster.
- Has leadership ability and can get results.
- Can size up a situation and provide necessary support.
- Is dependable.
- Has completed Cub Scout Leader or Boy Scout Leader Basic Training, or the Outdoor Training.
- Must have completed Youth Protection Training within the past two years. Note: can take on line.
- Follows the Guide to Safe Scouting.
