



Directions to Brown Memorial Camp The camp address is 1038 1935 Lane
 The camp phone number is 785-263-3546

From Abilene (Interstate 70)

1. Take K15, sometimes called Buckeye, south through town. K15 is the main north/south street in town.
2. Go south out of town about three miles, cross the Smokey Hill River.
3. After crossing the Smokey Hill River, look for Brown's Park signs and turn left (east) onto Hawk Road.
4. Take Hawk Road east, it will turn right and continue south as it borders Browns Park.
5. Turn left (east) onto 1935 Lane. Look for the watertower that this road goes by.
6. Stay on 1935 Lane, into the park until the road Y's. Turn right as the sign will read BOY SCOUTS and point to the right.
7. Take this road down a short hill to a T intersection. At the T intersection you will have a bridge on your left. Do not cross the bridge.
8. Turn right into Brown Memorial Camp and go into the main gate (gravel road) to the parking lot. The dining hall is the long, large building in front of the parking lot.

From Salina, KS

1. Take Country Club Road (by the golf course) east about 19 miles to state highway K15. About half way, you will enter Dickenson County. In Dickenson County, this road is called 1700 Avenue.
2. Turn left (north) onto K15 and travel 2 to 3 miles to 1900 Avenue.
3. Turn right (east) onto 1900 Avenue until you reach Hawk Road. At Hawk Road intersection, 1900 Avenue will turn into a gravel road.
 (Note: The gravel road will take you to the camp's back gate).
4. Turn off 1900 Avenue and turn left (north) onto Hawk Road.
5. Take Hawk Road north to the entrance of Brown's Park. This is 1935 Lane.
6. Turn right (east) onto 1935 Lane and follow above directions (see #5) to main gate.
