What is a Camporee?

A Camporee is an event for all Scouts and Scouters in a geographical district to get together for a large event featuring activities around a centralized theme. The event will last from Friday evening and will run through about noon on Sunday. Units are allowed to come and go as they need, whether coming on Saturday morning or leaving Saturday Night. The event allow Units to get to know others from the same district as well as gives the district the opportunity to put on a large scale event with constant activities. This gives units the opportunity to get together and make new friends while working on advancement and earning merit badges.

Registration: \$15.00 per person and is due at time of registration. Webelos 15.00 per person. If preregistered you will still need to check in. All Troops are required to fill out a registration. No individual payments. Please pay as a group on one check.

The registration fee covers the cost of the event, awards, insurance, Spring Camporee Patch, and council overhead. Fees not refundable.

Webelos: All Webelos may participate in the events of Sail Boating/Canoeing and Mountain Biking and can work towards their own advancement.

Check-In: **Dates/Times:** **Friday, April 30th from 6pm – 10pm or Saturday, May 1st from 8:00am – 9:30 AM**
All units should send a representative to the registration desk at the Lodge at the Camp Lakeside camp to turn in all necessary paper work, look for the people wearing hats with the official Spring Camporee Patch. Also, pay for all attendees and any other financial settlements. Troops will then be told where to proceed for a camp site or there is the option to stay in the lodge.

Event Agenda: The event's agenda is included in this packet. A revised agenda reflecting any changes will be available at the registration and at the Head Quarters and with event staff.

Adult Participation: We would like adults to participate with the youth and have fun on the Sailboats/Canoeing and Mountain Biking.

Campsites: All Scouts will be shown where to camp once arriving at the event. Please keep area orderly and leave no trace as we are all guests to the site.

Fires: Open fires must be kept in designated area at your campsite. Wood may be obtained from any downed trees

or you may bring your own. No cutting of standing or live trees

- Campfire:** There will be a campfire on Saturday Night at the Lakeview Campfire Ring. The entertainment will be a local acoustic guitar player. The scouts will be awarded their Spring Camporee Patches at this time by Matt Stuchlik – Buffalo Bill District Executive.
- Attire:** Please remember we will be doing various activities including being on the water, mountain biking and playing basketball and football. Class A not required.
- Food:** Each troop is responsible for its own meals during the event. Patrol cooking is encouraged. Patrols should plan a hot portion for each meal. This a good way to work on Cooking Merit Badge requirements as well rank advancement requirements.
- Water:** Water will be available from the various spigots around and in the Lodge.
- Latrines:** "Leave No Trace" camping will be used. Restrooms are available on site and in the Lodge.
- First Aid:** There will be a first aid station open at all times during the Spring Camporee located at the event Lodge. All injuries, however slight, must be reported to the first aid station.
- Trash:** All Troops are responsible for their own trash. All trash must be packed out on Sunday morning.
REMEMBER: If you pack it in, you pack it out.
- Lost & Found:** The Head Quarters at the Lodge will serve as the repository for found items. To minimize lost gear, Scouts should label all personal gear with name and unit number.
- Reminders:** Two adult leaders, at least twenty-one (21) years old, must be present with the unit except during the competition). As always, drugs, alcohol, fireworks, sheath knives, etc. are not allowed.
