A. A troop or team unit committee or the lodge adviser, council president or a professional staff member may recommend to the Lodge Adult Selection Committee, one adult (troops with 51 registered active youth may recommend two adults) for consideration as a candidate for induction, provided the following conditions are fulfilled. The Troop or Team must have at least one youth elected.

➤ The selection of an adult is based upon his or her ability to perform the necessary functions, and not to be used as an honor or for recognition of service, including current or prior achievements and positions. This individual's abilities, clearly stated, include:

➤ The adult will be an asset to the Order due to demonstrated skills and abilities, which fulfill the purpose of the Order, because:

➤ All camping requirements set forth for youth candidates apply to adult candidates and must have been fulfilled within the most recent two years prior to the recommendation for membership. The requirement is: a Scouter must complete a minimum of fifteen days and nights of camping under the auspices and standards of the Boy Scouts of America, including one, but not more than one, long term camp of six consecutive days and five nights. The remainder is short term or weekend camping. **Please list each event and the actual dates they took place.**

➤ This adult leader's membership will provide a positive example for growth and development of the youth members of the lodge because:

Adults are recommended to the Lodge Adult Selection Committee using the above four conditions as a basis. Upon approval by the Lodge Adult Selection Committee the adult becomes an official Ordeal Candidate. If the applicant is not approved, the citation fee will be refunded.
